

HJR 190 -- POWERS OF STATE GOVERNMENT

SPONSOR: Wolfin

Upon voter approval, this constitutional amendment proposes that the powers of the State government will be limited solely to those powers explicitly enumerated in the Constitution. No branch of government or officer or agency can exercise any power not granted or delegated by the Constitution expressly or by necessary implication, and acts beyond the scope of the enumerated powers is prohibited and will be deemed null and void.
