

HJR 191 -- JOINT COMMITTEE ON CONSERVATION OVERSIGHT

SPONSOR: Cook

Upon voter approval, this constitutional amendment creates the Joint Committee on Conservation Oversight. The Committee will consist of three representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and three senators appointed by the President Pro Tem of the Senate. The Committee will receive requests for approval from the Department of Conservation or the Conservation Commission relating to changes in rule or regulations, the purchase of any real property, the selection of a director or deputy director of the Department, and other matters as provided by general law.

This bill is similar to HJR 101 (2025).
