

HJR 194 -- TOLL ROADS

SPONSOR: Riggs

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment would authorize the expenditure of state funds by the Department of Transportation for use in constructing and operating toll roads approved by the Federal government and the General Assembly on interstate or four-lane roads with the restriction that toll rates be set by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission subject to legislative approval and that tolls be collected only at the entrances to interstates or four-lane roads. Revenues collected from such tolls will not be included within the definitions of the following terms in the Constitution of Missouri:

- (1) "Total state revenues" under Article X, Section 17;
- (2) "New annual revenues" under Article X, Section 18(e); or
- (3) "Expenses of state government" under Article X, Section 20.
