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HB 1831 expressly authorizes law enforcement to stop, inspect, and detain individuals solely to determine compliance with child-passenger motorcycle requirements.

That language matters.

A stop based only on an officer’s visual estimation of a child’s age — without independent traffic violation or criminal suspicion — creates foreseeable Fourth Amendment suppression challenges.

Age estimation is inherently subjective.

Subjective enforcement invites inconsistency.

Inconsistency invites litigation.

The State’s interest in child safety is legitimate. But expanding stop authority beyond traditional traffic violations must be narrowly tailored and clearly bounded. As drafted, HB 1831 creates constitutional friction where none currently exists.

Legislative Notice:

The General Assembly is therefore on notice that the stop-and-detain provision in section 302.023(4) presents foreseeable search-and-seizure vulnerability and enforcement challenges that should be addressed before enactment.
