HB 2958 is the state saying:

“We’ll assume you’re cheating, and you can pay to prove you’re not.”

That’s the opposite of due process (Mo. Const. Art. I, §10; 14th Amendment).

It pairs that presumption with financial punishment—\$500 penalties and 75% fines—and then threatens the working person’s lifeline: license suspension.

That’s coercion dressed up as compliance and it collides with the constitutional limits on excessive fines (Mo. Const. Art. I, §21; U.S. Const. amend. VIII).

**This is not targeted enforcement.
It’s a dragnet.**

Missouri should not trade constitutional rights for administrative convenience. Vote NO.
