**Written Testimony in Support of Missouri House Bill 3113
 Drug Abuse – Naloxone Access, Fentanyl Education, and Drug-Related Death Investigations
 Submitted by: Anita Puckett
 Position: Support**

My name is Anita Puckett, and I am writing this testimony in support of Missouri House Bill 3113.

In the early evening of July 25, 2021, I had the last phone conversation I would ever have with my son, Kevin. Sometime after midnight, Kevin was poisoned by fentanyl. He was 27 years old.

Kevin had been in recovery for approximately one year. Like many individuals in recovery, he suffered a relapse. However, instead of receiving heroin, he received pure fentanyl. Toxicology confirmed that fentanyl was the only substance in his system. There were no other drugs present.

Kevin died alone in his room at an Oxford house. His body was not discovered for approximately 40 hours after his death. Kevin’s death certificate lists his death as July 27, 2021, which is the date he was finally checked on in the so-called recovery home. The circumstances surrounding Kevin’s death reveal multiple systemic failures, this House Bill 3113 directly seeks to address some of them.

Kevin died of fentanyl poisoning, a medical emergency that is now tragically common. House Bill 3113’s requirement that public buildings maintain naloxone supplies, clearly mark their location, and educate occupants on emergency response is a critical step. Naloxone cannot save lives if it is locked away, unmarked, or misunderstood. This bill recognizes that access and awareness must go hand in hand.

Equally disturbing was what happened after Kevin’s death. Detectives took possession of Kevin’s phone and kept it for 3 months. During that time, they never opened it. They did not review messages, calls, or communications that could have identified the source of the fentanyl that killed him. Repeated phone calls from me went unanswered. We received no updates, no explanations, and no indication that an investigation was taking place. In reality, Kevin’s death was never investigated. This was a clear case of fentanyl poisoning resulting from illegal distribution. Yet his death was treated as routine, administrative, and disposable.

This is precisely why House Bill 3113’s provision requiring all drug-related deaths to be fully investigated and treated as homicide crime scenes is so important. Drug poisoning deaths are not accidents; they are the result of illegal distribution. When these deaths are not investigated, traffickers

remain free to poison others and they do.

Kevin was not ignorant of drugs. He had been in recovery. But fentanyl has fundamentally changed the drug landscape. Relapse today does not look like relapse of years ago, prior to illicit fentanyl inundating this country. Individuals no longer encounter what they believe they are using; they encounter fentanyl.

House Bill 3113's emphasis on fentanyl-specific education for students, as well as broader community education, is essential. Awareness must reflect reality. Fentanyl is not just another opioid, it is a lethal poison, and exposure is often fatal.

My son had value; his life mattered. Yet his death was met with indifference, no emergency response, no investigation, no accountability.

House Bill 3113 acknowledges what too many families already know:

- Fentanyl poisoning is a public health emergency
- Naloxone access saves lives
- Education must reflect the reality of today's drug supply
- Drug-related deaths deserve full investigation, not dismissal

Had these measures been in place and enforced, my son's outcome, and our family's trauma, may have been different.

I urge this committee to pass House Bill 3113 and send a clear message that fentanyl poisoning deaths will be taken seriously, investigated thoroughly, and prevented aggressively whenever possible.

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Chairman and Members of the Committee,

My name is Dayna Blanar. I am a wife, mother, grandmother, and the founder of Missouri/Kansas Families Affected by Fentanyl Poisoning. I am also a federal civilian employee at Fort Leonard Wood, and my husband is a retired military police officer. I have multiple family members in law enforcement, and I deeply respect the responsibility and pressure that comes with public service.

I submit this written testimony in strong support of House Bill 3113. I am here because my son, Zachary, died from fentanyl poisoning after unknowingly ingesting fentanyl that had been laced into marijuana. Zachary is not a statistic. He is a son and a father, and his life and legacy continue to guide our family. He matters.

When my son died, I should have been allowed to grieve. Instead, I felt forced to become an investigator. I should never have felt compelled to request and review forensic and autopsy photographs of my child just to understand what happened to him. No mother should ever have to see her son's photo in a morgue to determine whether the truth was fully pursued. Those images haunt me, but they also revealed how easily critical questions can go unanswered when drug related deaths are not treated with the seriousness they deserve. At one point, I was told by law enforcement that my son's case had "fallen through the cracks." No family should ever hear those words after losing a loved one. That moment made it painfully clear to me that what happened to my son was not just a personal tragedy, it exposed systemic gaps that leave families without answers. This is why House Bill 3113 is necessary.

HB 3113 recognizes fentanyl poisoning for what it truly is a public safety crisis, not a moral failure or an unfortunate accident. There was nothing accidental about my son's death. Fentanyl is a synthetic poison, often introduced without a person's knowledge, and there is no safe amount. When deaths like my son's are treated casually or inconsistently, justice, prevention, and public trust all suffer.

The bill's requirement for naloxone availability in public buildings is a practical, life saving measure. Just as AEDs are placed in public spaces to prevent avoidable deaths, naloxone must be accessible where lives can be saved immediately.

The designation of Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month is equally important. Education should not be

reactive or left to grieving families. It must be proactive, visible, and supported statewide so awareness reaches people before tragedy occurs.

The education and prevention provisions of HB 3113 are especially personal to me.

After my son Zachary died I attended a parent-teacher conference, there I learned that my adopted daughter, who is my son Zachary's biological child, had been bringing fentanyl awareness bracelets to school. She was giving them to her teacher and talking with her teacher and classmates about fentanyl. Her teacher told me she had never known about fentanyl before, but she looked it up and was shocked by how severely it is affecting people. It took an eight year old child who was grieving her to make an adult aware of the dangerous poison that continues to take lives daily.

One day, when my same daughter saw me crying, she said, "Mama, it's okay. God had to take Zachary so that we could learn about fentanyl and teach others about it." Her strength and understanding amazes me, but as a child she should not have to carry that level of understanding or responsibility. Yet children who have already lost so much are often the first voices warning others. They should not have to educate teachers and classmates through their grief. HB 3113 helps ensure that education is intentional, consistent, and supported rather than trauma driven.

Most critically, HB 3113 requires that every drug related death be investigated and treated as a homicide crime scene, regardless of whether charges are ultimately filed. This provision is not about assigning blame prematurely. It is about preserving evidence, ensuring proper investigative procedures, and seeking truth. Families deserve to know their loved one's death was taken seriously and handled with dignity.

HB 3113 does not attack law enforcement, it supports them through training, clarity, and consistent standards. It does not criminalize victims, it honors them by recognizing the seriousness of how they died.

Scripture tells us in Proverbs 31:8-9 to "speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves." I submit this testimony in that spirit, speaking for my son, whose life still speaks, and for Missouri families who should be grieving, not investigating.

I respectfully urge you to support House Bill 3113 and take a meaningful step toward accountability, prevention, and protection for Missouri families.

 ?Treatment of Homicide Scenes: Section 590.1700, which requires drug-related deaths to be treated as homicide crime scenes, is crucial. My daughter's life was stolen. Treating her death as anything less than a homicide initially allows evidence to grow cold and predators to walk free.
 ?Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness: Designating October as "Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month" (Section 9.507) honors the truth. This was not an "overdose" in the traditional sense of a choice made; it was a poisoning from an illicit, counterfeit source.
 ?Life-Saving Infrastructure: Requiring naloxone in public buildings (Section 8.990) ensures that when seconds count, the tools for survival are within reach. In our "86 Project," we call this the "86 Kit": no questions asked, just keeping people alive.

He was gone. My life as I knew it was gone. His plans to join the Navy were gone. His future with his girlfriend was gone. Any potential children he'd have were gone. After reading his phone messages I found out he'd left in a cab the night before and went to his best friend across town to purchase these pills. The evidence was there. The friend telling him to be careful because he could die from it. The friend acknowledging he'd sold my son something lethal. Then there were messages later that had jumbled letters mixed in. Jake telling his friend he didn't feel right. His friend knew at this point Jake was in trouble. He could've called me to check on Jake. He could've called the police for a well check to my address. I was in bed asleep but I would've woke up if someone had called or rang the doorbell. His friend knew he sold him a deadly drug, then knew he was in trouble and did nothing. And then the police and the detective that took Jake's phone and the prosecutor did NOTHING. And Jake's friend could still be selling a death sentence to people he knows and claims to be a friend of.

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**Written Testimony in Support of House Bill 3113
 Missouri General Assembly – Judiciary Committee**

Chair and Members of the Committee:

My name is Tena Pruitt, RN. I submit this testimony in support of House Bill 3113.

I appear before you as both a registered nurse and a parent whose child died as a direct result of illicit fentanyl poisoning. My son, Logan Albert Harris, was 22 years old at the time of his death. He had no history of criminal behavior and no documented substance use disorder. He ingested what he reasonably believed to be a legitimate pharmaceutical pill. That pill contained illicit fentanyl. The exposure was fatal.

From a medical and forensic perspective, fentanyl-related fatalities are routinely mischaracterized. Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid with extreme potency; microgram quantities are sufficient to cause respiratory arrest. When fentanyl is introduced into a substance without the user’s knowledge, the resulting death is not the result of misuse or voluntary risk escalation. It is toxic exposure without informed consent, which meets the medical definition of poisoning.

In clinical practice, when a patient receives a lethal substance unknowingly, the event is classified as poisoning, not overdose. That distinction is not semantic; it directly relates to causation, foreseeability, and accountability. House Bill 3113 reflects this distinction by appropriately linking distribution of illicit fentanyl to resulting death and establishing legal responsibility where that causal chain exists.

House Bill 3113 does not criminalize addiction, nor does it target individuals suffering from substance use disorder. Instead, it addresses conduct upstream—the manufacture, distribution, and sale of an inherently lethal substance, when that conduct results in loss of life. This aligns with long-standing principles of criminal liability where death is a foreseeable outcome of an unlawful act.

In addition to supporting accountability measures, I urge the legislature to recognize the preventive and mitigation role of emergency intervention, particularly in schools. As a nurse who now provides fentanyl education in school settings, I strongly recommend that schools be required to maintain naloxone (Narcan) on site at all times. Naloxone is safe, non-addictive, and easy to administer. In opioid toxicity events, immediate access can be determinative of survival while emergency medical services are en route.

Education, emergency preparedness, and legal accountability are not competing strategies—they are complementary. HP 3113 advances accountability. Readily available naloxone mitigates harm when prevention fails.

The death of my son was preventable. So are many others. House Bill 3113 represents a legally sound and medically informed step toward addressing the fentanyl crisis with accuracy and seriousness.

I respectfully urge the Committee to advance House Bill 3113.

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While the intent to address the overdose crisis is recognized, this bill represents a deeply flawed and harmful approach that will exacerbate the very problems it seeks to solve. Its core framework prioritizes criminalization and punitive measures over the public health solutions that are proven to save lives.

The bill’s expansion of law enforcement resources and mandates for schools to collaborate with police will inevitably lead to increased surveillance and punitive interactions for students, disproportionately impacting Black, Brown, and low-income youth. Treating a public health emergency as a matter for enhanced “apprehension” funnels vulnerable individuals into the criminal legal system instead of into care and support. The directive to investigate every drug-related death as a homicide scene will criminalize grief and trauma, potentially targeting friends and family members who are also victims of the crisis, rather than focusing on the systemic causes and the suppliers of contaminated substances.

While designating a Fentanyl Awareness Month and requiring naloxone in public buildings are positive steps, they are overshadowed by the bill’s overwhelming investment in failed punitive strategies. True progress requires a radical reallocation of these resources toward harm reduction, such as widespread distribution of naloxone and fentanyl test strips, funding for evidence-based drug education that is not tied to law enforcement, and massive investment in accessible, voluntary treatment, mental health services, and safe consumption spaces. This bill doubles down on the war on drugs, a policy that has devastated communities for decades. We must choose compassion over coercion and health over punishment.

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HB 3113 is a textbook example of a bill that bundles public-health optics with law-enforcement expansion in a way that creates constitutional risk, mission creep, and unintended harm, particularly in schools and public spaces.

While naloxone access and overdose prevention are legitimate public-health goals, this bill collapses critical distinctions between medical response, public education, and criminal investigation, resulting in a structure that discourages life-saving intervention and chills reporting.

Requiring naloxone in public buildings is a health policy choice; mandating that every drug-related death be treated as a homicide crime scene is a criminal-procedure decision with serious Fourth Amendment and due-process implications.

Treating overdose deaths as homicides by default risks deterring witnesses, bystanders, school staff, and family members from calling for emergency assistance — directly undermining Good Samaritan principles and increasing, rather than decreasing, preventable fatalities.

The bill further expands law enforcement authority into school settings under the banner of “enhanced apprehension,” without corresponding statutory guardrails, civil-rights protections, or independent oversight.

This mirrors a recurring legislative pattern: increasing enforcement mandates without addressing existing failures in reporting, response consistency, or accountability.

Schools are already struggling under overlapping obligations involving student discipline, mandated reporting, and parental rights; layering homicide-scene protocols onto drug-related deaths within or near schools is reckless and legally unsound.

Finally, HB 3113 bundles unrelated provisions — public-health supply mandates, awareness months, POST training requirements, and homicide-scene directives — into a single bill, limiting meaningful legislative scrutiny and masking the most consequential change behind widely supported harm-reduction language.

Missouri does not need symbolic “toughness” legislation; it needs clear separation between medical emergency response and criminal investigation, grounded in constitutional limits and evidence-based outcomes.

For these reasons, HB 3113 should be rejected or substantially narrowed to remove the automatic homicide-scene mandate and to restore a clear, lawful boundary between public health intervention and criminal enforcement.

Legislators who hope to serve in future General Assemblies should remember that bad law does not age well. Bills passed in haste and drafted without constitutional discipline become tomorrow's overturned statutes, costly litigation, and public mistrust. A vote against unconstitutional legislation is not weakness — it is foresight.

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There are several items in the bill that i strongly support, especially the prevention focused items including requiring naloxone in public buildings, but overall, i have some concerns about some of the proposed language:

- Development of education and prevention and intervention programs - there are already evidence-based education and programs available that are backed by research and documented to provide positive outcomes when provided with fidelity.
- The focus on punishment / apprehension - evidence supports a focus on prevention and diversion to treatment. Punishment is not effective in supporting individuals to engage in treatment or encouraging them to decrease or cease use. Punishment is often inequitably applied and further marginalizes at risk community members.
- 590.198 - This training is focused again on punishment, where crisis intervention training by Missouri Crisis Intervention Team councils is focused on de-escalation, connection to treatment, and diversion from jails/ERs.
- My biggest concern relates to 590.1700, particularly that any drug related death be treated as a homicide crime scene as this focus on punishment, again, is inequitably applied and further marginalizes at risk community members.

I believe the intent behind the bill to save lives and protect our communities is worthy, but some of the wording goes against that intent. If prevention specialists, treatment specialists, and people with lived experience were involved in the formation of the bill, it could be greatly strengthened.
